

Weed Abatement



The Calimesa Fire Department would like to remind all property owners of their responsibility of compliance with the Calimesa Municipal Code Chapter 8.10, requiring the abatement of weeds, flammable vegetation and other combustible matter for all developed or undeveloped properties. Due to the recent rainfall, the City has experienced an early growth of flammable vegetation, which poses a fire hazard and endangers people and properties.

PLEASE BE ADVISED: The Calimesa Fire Department will begin property inspections early February. Property Owners who are in violation of CMC Chapter 8.10 will be sent a “Notice to Abate” from the Calimesa Fire Department. Property owners will have 30 days to abate their properties and bring them into compliance.
